Daily Life in Central Asia

Capture the essence of Central Asia in a picture

Theme of the competition

The SEnECA project aims at bringing Central Asia closer to Europe by familiarising citizens of both regions with their connections and similarities and their day by day life. For this purpose, the Trans European Policy Association (TEPSA) is organising a photo contest on daily life in Central Asia. Photos submitted are encouraged to feature ordinary life in the countries of Central Asia, from the city to the countryside, covering all categories that define how an ordinary day in Central Asia looks like. The best 50 pictures will be displayed in a photo exhibition on the 4 and 5 April 2019 at the Centre for Fine Arts (BOZAR) in Brussels.

Prize

Five participants will be awarded with a trip to Brussels for the opening of the EU-Central Asia Photo Exhibition. Travel and accommodation costs will be fully covered.

How to enter the contest

Participants may enter SEnECA's Photo Contest by submitting up to 10 photos by **30 November 2018** in an email to seneca@tepsa.eu. Photos can be attached in JPEG, PDF and PNG format or sent via an online platform (e.g. Wetransfer). Please use *SEnECA Photo Contest_SURNAME* as subject of your email.

Every picture must be accompanied by a title and a short description (one paragraph) of what the photo intends to tell.

There is no fee for entering the contest.

Eligibility

The contest is open to residents in Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, as well as EU residents.

Participants must be 18 or over.



Entrants of the contest can be professional photographers as well as talented amateurs.

Entries that are offensive, defamatory or obscene, or that disclose unnecessary personal information will be rejected from the competition.

Images with copyright watermarks and text will be rejected: however, photos where only dates or titles appear are eligible.

Copyright rules

All entries must be original work and the participant must either be the sole owner or the transferee of the copyright. By entering the competition, participants retain full copyright of their images. Participants also grant SEnECA the right to publish and exhibit uploaded photographs. No fee will be payable by SEnECA for this use.

The photograph must neither be previously submitted, in whole or in part, to any other competitions, although it can have been previously displayed in the participant's social media accounts or website.

The size of the photo file must be at least 2 MB. Once submitted, the photographers provide SEnECA the right to use the photos on educational and other promotional materials with appropriate credits to the photographer.

Participants must obtain written consent from any individuals who are identifiable in a photograph. It is the participants' responsibility to ensure that the necessary consent has been obtained. Participants must retain all consent forms obtained as they may be asked to prove that consent has been given. Please find a template of a consent form at the end of this document

Selection of Winners

TEPSA will evaluate all submitted photographs and inform the winners by the end of December 2018.

Acceptance of Contest Rules

By entering this photo contest, the participants agree to be bound by the Contest Rules, including assurances on the copyright of entries.

Moderation

All photos are checked to make sure that they meet the competition rules before being accepted into the contest.
